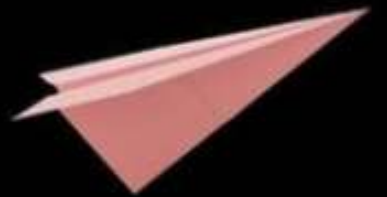

DON'T TRY TOO HARD !!

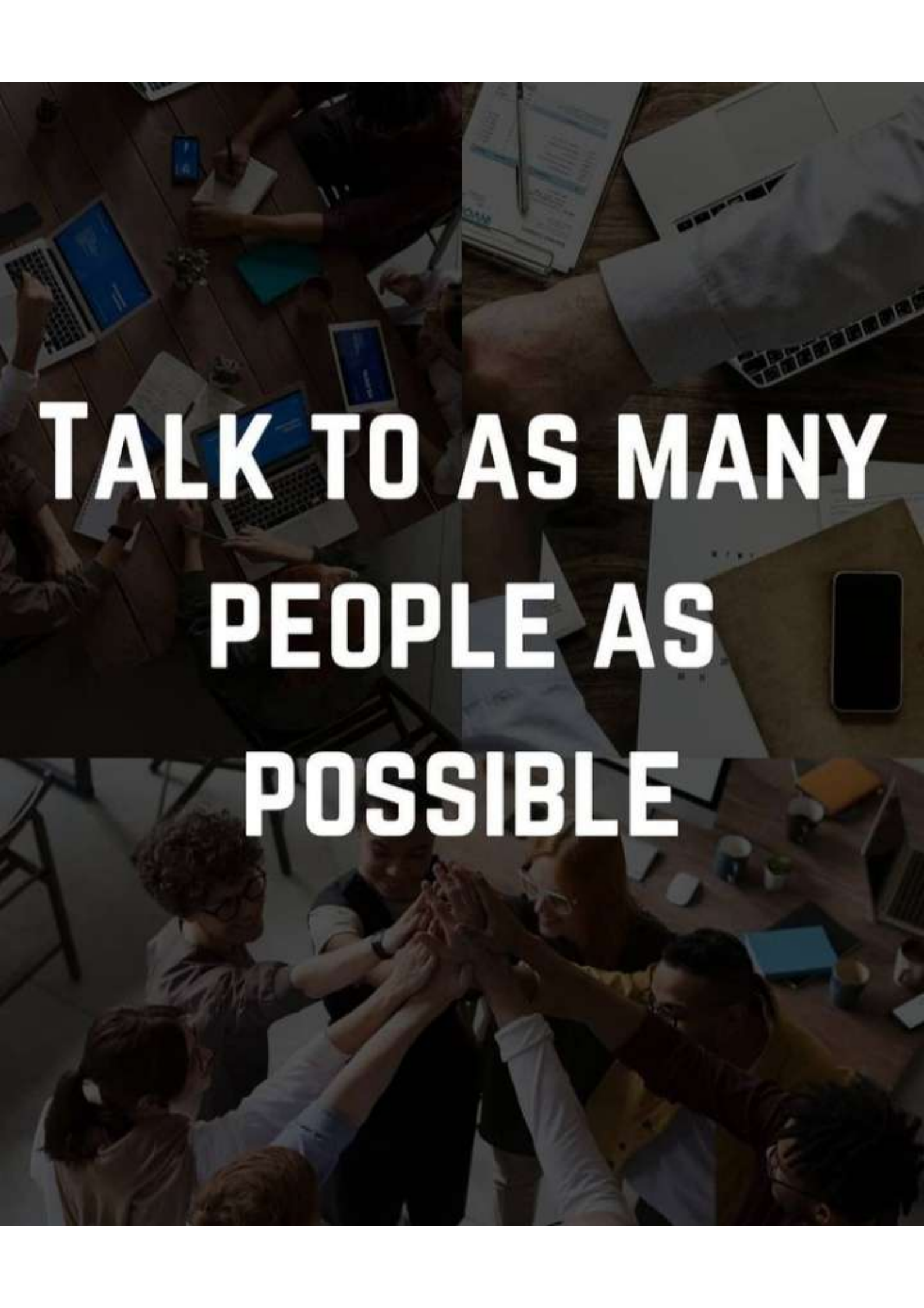
THE URGE TO IMPRESS CAN TAKE YOU OFF-TRACK, SO REMEMBER THAT YOU'RE ALREADY HIRED
